All vessels with LOA of more than 20 metres, bound to or from the Port of Edenstown must communicate by VHF with Edenstown VTS.

When making contact with VTS, use VHF channel 12, speak in English only and use message markers and Standard Marine Vocabulary phrases.

Vessels must report to VTS 30 minutes before getting underway. When reporting outward vessels must provide: name, draught, number of persons on board, intended route and ETA at the next reporting point.

All vessels must contact VTS to obtain permission from VTS before letting go.

Vessels within the Edenstown VTS area may call other vessels on VHF Ch. 12 and then switch to a different working channel.

Whilst at anchor vessels must maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch. 12.

There is a traffic and navigational broadcast on the hour from 0600 to 2200.

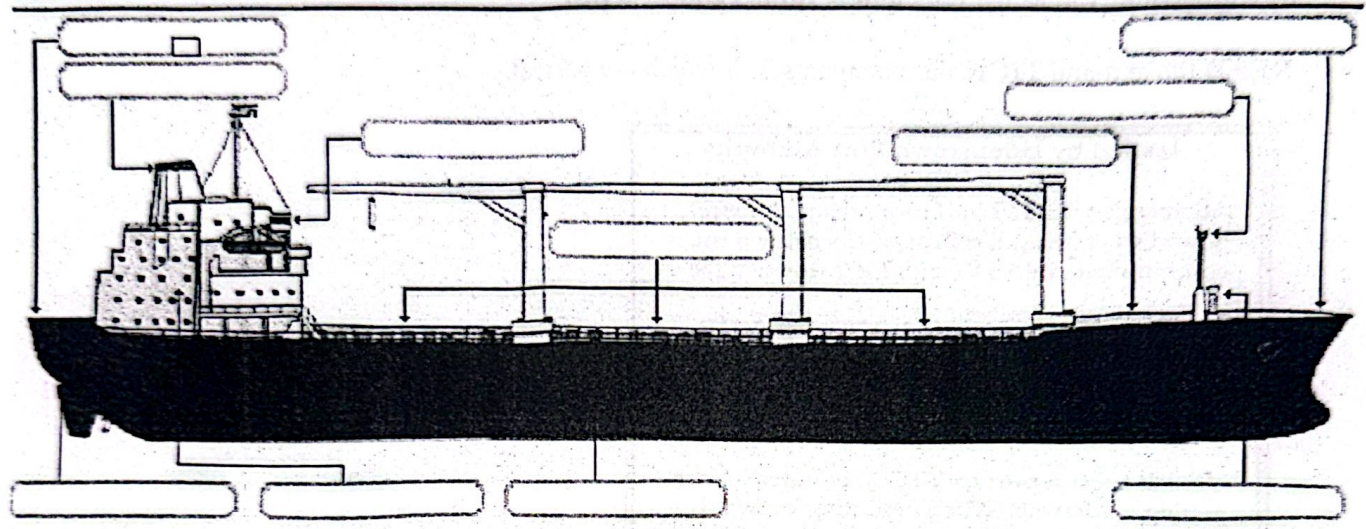
